

# DRESS RULES

Gosforth Golf Club seeks to promote a friendly, relaxed atmosphere in which members and guests can enjoy the course and Clubhouse facilities. Although casual dress is permitted on and off the course, it is important that the term "casual" is not abused and that the Club's standards are followed at all times.

Please be aware that anyone found not complying with these Dress Rules would not be permitted to play golf or enter the Clubhouse.

## On the course

### Shoes

Golf shoes (spikes or tee grips).

#### Not permitted

Training shoes (except for under 11's where permission has been obtained in advance from the Professional).

### Shorts & socks

Tailored shorts, worn with sports, ankle or knee length socks. (Sports socks are defined as white or colour coordinated). Socks must be worn with all footwear.

#### Not permitted

Athletic, beach, boxer, football/rugby, swimming shorts.

### Long trousers

Tailored trousers, smart trousers with external side pockets, Plus 2s, Crops.

Long or mid calf cargo/combat style trousers.

#### Not permitted

Denim and brushed denim jeans.

Trouser legs tucked into socks.

Tracksuit or shell suit bottoms worn separately.

No camouflage dress at all.

### Shirts

Shirts with collars and long or short sleeves, including sleeveless with a collar, mock turtleneck.

Shirts MUST be tucked in at all times. Shirts designed exclusively not to be tucked in are excluded.

#### Not permitted

Singlets, tee shirts, football/rugby shirts, tracksuit or shell suit tops worn separately.

The Professional is the final arbiter in any query regarding the Dress Code on the course.
