### GOSFORTH GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

- Out of bounds.** Ball lying beyond any fence, hedge or burn surrounding the course is out of bounds. Ball level with or past the white stakes around the putting green and all paths in front of the clubhouse is out of bounds.
  - 4th Hole.** (a) Out of bounds is defined by the white stakes on the right of the fairway including over the burn. (ii) **7th hole.** Out of bounds is defined by the white stakes on the right hand side and thereafter by the hedge and fence.
- The Burn.** The burn between the 15th and 18th holes as marked by the red posts is a lateral water hazard. Rule 26.1c applies. All other streams or burns are water hazards. Rule 26.1 applies.
- Stones.** Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Rule 24.1 applies.
- Young Trees.** Protection of young trees which are staked. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance, or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2(b) (i) (Immovable Obstruction).
- Fixed Sprinkler Heads.** All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24.2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty, as follows: if the ball lies off the green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention, and (c) is not in a hazard or on a green.
- The Yellow Discs located in the centre of the fairways on all par 4s and 5s, except holes 6 and 17, indicate 150 yards to the centre of the green. The approximate location of these discs is indicated by prominent trees at the side of the fairway. The marker discs are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24.2.
- Where *Astro Turf* covers are on the line of a putt, the ball may be placed, not nearer the hole, at the nearest point of relief that avoids the cover. Rule 24.2 (iii) applies.
- Distance Measuring Devices**  
The use of such devices or GPS yardage finder is permitted in all club competitions.
